

Parents applying for their child to attend VPK must provide documentation to prove their child currently lives in Florida by providing a copy of at least one of the following supporting documents that shows the name and current residential address of the parent listed on the application with whom the child resides.

(Rule 6M-8.201, F.A.C.)

- Government-issued document such as:
 - Florida Driver's License or Identification card
 - Consular Identification Card
 - Voter Information card
 - Vehicle registration
 - Homestead Exemption
 - Award Letters such as:
 - Food Stamps/Medicaid
 - Child Support
- A utility bill (electric, gas, water, cable or home phone) in its entirety that is dated within the last twelve months. Bills for internet services only are not acceptable.
- Pay stub dated within last twelve months
- Residential rental agreement (lease) with completed signature page or receipt from rental payment dated within last twelve months
- Military order showing that the child's parent is a service member in the United States Armed Forces and is assigned to duty in Florida
- Federal government order showing that the child's parent is a federal employee assigned to work in Florida
- A Florida Migrant Education Program Certificate of Eligibility (COE) Form from the Florida Department of Education
- If none of the above supporting documents are available, a notarized affidavit from the child's parent stating the child's address can be accepted. This affidavit must include or be accompanied by a signed statement or letter from the landlord, property owner, or property lease confirming the child resides at the address shown in the affidavit.
- For a child who is experiencing homelessness* other documents showing that the child resides in Florida such as a letter from a homeless shelter, homeless referral, or notarized statement from the child's parent.
