


Explore Kindergarten: Team Scavenger Hunt

Let's begin in the classroom:




The place where I keep my things

Connect to literature

Teachers may use early literacy books to complement the school scavenger hunt activity. Some book suggestions are: "We're Going on a Bear Hunt" by Helen Oxenbury, "Rooster's Off to See the World" by Eric Carle, "Rosie's Walk" by Pat Hutchins and "The Gingerbread Man is Loose in the School" by Laura Murray.

Teachers may use visual key and place it at each specific location beyond the classroom prior to beginning the school scavenger hunt with the students. This will help students find each location as they look for the visual key (e.g. a star, a gingerbread man, animal pictures, bears).
