

What is the Florida Kindergarten Readiness Screener (FLKRS)?

Every kindergarten student is administered an assessment called the *Florida Kindergarten Readiness Screener* within 30 days after starting school. These results give families and teachers important information about a child's readiness for school and to plan instruction and learning opportunities.

FLKRS Quick Facts

- Students take the assessment within 30 days after starting kindergarten.
- The assessment has two main areas: early literacy and early mathematics.
- The assessment is given in class on a computer and takes 10-15 minutes.
- Helping your child learn these skills will build a foundation for success in kindergarten and beyond.

Some of the basic skills assessed in the FLKRS are:

- *letter recognition*
- *sound recognition*
- *phonemic awareness*
- *vocabulary*
- *number awareness*
- *counting*
