Steps to Enroll at HCC

1. Complete the HCC [online application](#). Create an account if you do not have one. Select the **College Credit Certificate in Preschool Teaching (CCC.CHILD.PRE)** as your program. **Only list your high school on your application.**
2. After submitting your application, look for an email notifying you of your next steps, including information on setting up your [HCC Login](#). You will receive your HCC email address (Hawkmail) in the email, along with a student ID number. **Please use your Hawkmail account and include your HCC student ID in all communication with the college.** Click onto [Password](#) if you've forgotten your password. It may take up to 5 business days to be admitted.
3. Submit an official high school [transcript](#) immediately. **Registration will be delayed if a transcript is not received.** Opened, photocopied, scanned, faxed or transcripts emailed directly from a student are considered unofficial and will not be accepted.

The message will include steps to access the course and all materials. The instructor will give you the assigned textbook.
