# ARPA Workforce Initiatives

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## WORLD CLASS WORKFORCE

\$500 recruitment bonus (background screening and 120 hours of employment).

\$700 health and safety bonus (meet DCF requirements).

\$600 CLASS bonus for completion of CLASS Foundations for Teachers and MyTeachstone Learn Abouts.

\$750 Director bonus for completion of 29 hours of CLASS foundational content.

A Child Success Grant for CLASS below 5.0:

- a. \$500 bonus (\$600 Directors) for completing the first 24 hours of training
- b. \$700 bonus (\$800 Directors) for completing the second 24 hours of training
- c. \$500 performance bonus (\$600 Directors) for CLASS 5.0 or higher or CLASS improves by 0.5 or more

\$1,200 bonus for CLASS Observer Director Training Grant (14 hours of training)

\$19,800 grant to develop/implement a program to strengthen practices to support effective interactions, strengthen business and leadership practices, support child assessment and screening with reliability, or other local priorities if CLASS 5.0 or higher. Minimum 24 hours.

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### Helpful Acronym List

**ARPA** stands for *American Rescue Plan Act*: also called the COVID-19 Stimulus Package is a US \$19 trillion dollar economic stimulus bill passed by the 117th United States Congress and signed into law by President Joe Biden on March 11, 2021 to speed up the country's recovery from the economic and health effects of the COVID-19 pandemic and the ongoing recession.

**CLASS** (*Classroom Assessment Scoring System*) evaluation tool that helps identify areas where childcare providers can improve their quality interactions with children.

**VPK** stands for *Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten Program*

**SR** stands for *School Readiness Program*

**DEL** stands for the *Division of Early Learning*

**DEO** stands for the *State Department of Economic Opportunity*
