

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS FOR RFQ PARENT TRAINING SERIES

Please be advised all questions are keyed as submitted:

Question:

On page 2. C.1 it states: Quotes must be submitted via email no later than 5:00 pm EST on November 30, 2023. Quotes must not exceed \$34,999.

- Is the \$34,999 the total budget allowed for this RFQ?
- Are separate quotes for each topic allowed as long as they are within the specified \$34,999?

Answer:

Payments to each entity/company must not exceed \$34,999 per fiscal year. Separate/multiple quotes are allowed from the same company but the total of all submitted quotes cannot exceed \$34,999.

Question:

- 1. Is the ELC looking for organizations who have the capacity to serve the entire county or can smaller communities be targeted?
- 2. Will organizations be expected to recruit participants or will referrals come directly from ELC providers? Or some combination of the 2?

Answer:

- 1. Smaller communities/participant group maximums are allowed as part of the quote
- 2. A combination of the 2 will be used for recruiting participants

Question:

(1) Is it possible to request reconsideration of the date of November 27, 2023 for responses to questions as outlined on page 6 since that date is only three days prior to the deadline?

I visited the website provided on the RFQ <u>www.elchc.org</u> but did not see a list of training available to families. I only saw professional development for providers.

(2) Is this a new opportunity? If not, can you direct me to where I may locate a list of current parent/family training to avoid submitting duplicate or similar training?

(3) Are prospective contractors required to register on a procurement website before qualifying to respond to this *RFQ*? If so, please provide the link to the procurement site.



(4) In regards to a reference in the first paragraph of page 4: Can the survey data collected from parents and guardians be reviewed by prospective contractors prior to bid submission?

(5) In regard to H. Proprietary and Confidential Information, #4 on page 11: *Do prospective contractors retain their right of ownership for any and all training conducted as part of this contract?*

(6) On page 10 it states, "All insurance policies shall be with insurers qualified and doing business in Florida." *Can a waiver of this requirement be granted if the prospective contractor is based outside of the state of Florida and will be providing training services virtually?*
